Notice of Availability of Revised Environmental Assessment and Finding of No  
Significant Impact

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) has received a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) from the Federal Highway Administration to improve 8.3 miles of the Parks Highway beginning at Lucas Road (MP 44) in Wasilla and ending approximately a half mile past Big Lake Road (MP 52) in Houston. The Environmental Assessment (EA) and FONSI fully comply with the appropriate provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act. Pursuant to CEQ 1506.6, the EA and FONSI is available for public review at the DOT&PF Central Region Office at 4111 Aviation Avenue in Anchorage and can be viewed and downloaded online at [www.parkshighway44-52.info](http://www.parkshighway44-52.info).
