A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH REAL PROPERTY ASSET MANAGEMENT BOARD IN SUPPORT OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH MACHEN ROAD PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) identifies \$1.2 Billion of needed road improvements between 2007 and 2025; and

WHEREAS, during this same time period the borough's population is expected to more than double to 160,000 residents; and


WHEREAS, the transportation improvements identified in the LRTP must be programmed and funded for construction as early as possible in order to prevent congestion and unsafe conditions; and

WHEREAS, an east-west connection north of the Parks Highway on the west end of Wasilla will help reduce the traffic congestion, injuries, and fatalities on the Parks Highway; and

WHEREAS, this east-west connection will give the citizens of the Stanley Road area access to a signalized intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Real Property Asset Management Board supports the efforts of the Borough to construct the Machen Road Project.
