The projects included: the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities project Parks Highway 44-52: Lucas Road to Big Lake Road. Two projects being undertaken with state funding by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough called Parks Highway Connectors: Museum Drive Extension and Machen Road Extension. The final project in the group is the City of Wasilla's South Mack Drive Extension project that is studying how to provide a north south connection between the existing terminus of Mack Drive and Knik Goose Bay Road.
